I would like to have data on the number of fires your forces attended where the ignition source of the fire is recorded as 'white goods'.

Where white goods are appliances like fridges, washing machines, tumble dryers, dishwashers, refrigerators, freezers, kettles, coffee machines etc)

I need to have the table in an excel format and broken down by local authority area for the last two financial years (2017/18 and 2016/17).

Thank you for your request, dated 30 January 2019 requesting information on 'white goods' incidents.

In response, I'd like to direct you to the readily available information on the London Data store [here](#). This data set provides details of white goods fires attended by the LFB by London borough and ward location, and the type of white goods concerned as well as the property type where the fire happened. Where known, the brand and model of the white goods item is included. The data is from January 2009 and is current as of week ending 22.02.2019. This is updated annually,
