# Request:

I am currently on the look for fire damaged properties that have occurred in the harrow area in the past 30 day.

### Response:

A full list of incidents attended by the LFB is published via the <u>London Datastore</u> and can be accessed via this link: <u>https://data.london.gov.uk/dataset/london-fire-brigade-incident-records</u>.

If you download the '<u>LFB Incident Data from 2018</u>' dataset, you can search for the most recent incidents using column B, '*DateOfCall*'. The dataset is updated monthly and you can filter to see fire incidents that have occurred in Harrow using column G, '*StopCodeDescription*' and column Q, '*IncGeo\_BoroughName*'.

### Non-residential properties

Full postcode location is included in column L, 'Postcode\_full';

We do also publish the Unique Property Reference Number (UPRN) for each incident in column N. This is a unique numeric identifier for every spatial address in Great Britain. A web search for "UPRN" will provide you with various tools which can be used to identify the full postal address linked to the UPRN.

### Residential properties:

A part postcode is published in column M, 'Postcode\_district';

We do also publish the Unique Street Reference Number (USRN) for each incident in column 'O'. This is a unique numeric identifier for every street in Great Britain. A web search for "USRN" will provide you with various tools which can be used to identify the street address linked to the USRN.
