Regarding Forest School, College Place, Walthamstow, E17 3PY, the Fire Safety Audit was completed on 23.01.2022 and the outcome is 'Broadly Compliant'. This outcome confirms no enforcement action was taken. Following very recent internal discussions, the Brigade has decided to disclose redacted versions of the report from Fire Safety Audits carried out by LFB officers, where a building is found to be 'Broadly Compliant' with fire safety law. These were previously withheld. I have attached a copy of the most recent Fire Safety Audit Report for Forest School, to this email. Redactions have been made to this report to remove personal data, in accordance with Section 40 (2) of the FOIA.

Through Q&A and the review of documentation it was established that there is suitable and sufficient fire safety arrangements in place.

Fire alarm - *tested weekly and maintained in accordance with BS 5839-part1.

MOE - Checked daily by management and heads of department

EEL - Checked and tested monthly

Emergency plan - Simultaneous evacuation - drills every term

FFE - In service date and in suitable positions

Staff training - All staff are fully trained with 28 members taking the fire warden role

False alarms - False alarms are often due to pupils accidently setting off manual call points.

Due to the time delay on the alarm the brigade is not notified.

Article 13 - Detection and warning

Observations

The premises are fitted with a suitable fire alarm and detection system.

The system is a L3 in accordance wit BS 5839 -1

A system with automatic detection installed in escape routes and rooms leading onto the escape routes. Also, manual break glass call points are installed on all exits. The alarm panel is located in the main building entrance with repeater panels in buildings: Gilderdale, Sylvestrian Centre, workshop and science building.

The system is set to allow 3 minutes investigation prior to the bells sounding. This is overridden by a double knock.

When school is closed there is a security guard on site between 6pm-6am who investigates before contacting Estate manager and fire and rescue service. At the time of the inspection a fire alarm was activated by staff and a full evacuation was planned.

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Article 14 - Emergency routes and exits

SAFETY CRITICAL Safety Evaluation Broadly Compliant

Observations

Suitable & maintained emergency routes & exits both internally & externally. Relevant Persons can escape quickly and safely in event of a fire with assistance of staff if required.

Provisions in place for the evacuation strategy appear to be suitable.

All of the escape routes and exits were clear at the time of the audit.

The emergency routes adequately protected (where required) and exits lead directly as possible to a place of ultimate safety.

There are a sufficient number of emergency routes and exits, suitably located and adequate widths for the number of people using them.

Exits and doors on escape routes open in the correct direction for the number of people using the premises.

All exits and doors on escape routes fitted with simple door fastenings with emergency overrides/fail safe's.

There is suitable and sufficient signage and adequate emergency escape lighting system (where required)

A full fire drill was executed on the day of the inspection, all staff and pupils evacuated the buildings within 8 minutes in a calm and composed manner. A full sweep of the school is managed by the fire wardens. Red and Green cards are held up by staff once registration has been completed and all pupils and staff are accounted for. Red card indicates a missing person then management take over to locate person.

Article 15 - Procedures for serious and imminent danger and for danger areas

A comprehensive emergency action plan has been devised which addresses all relevant issues and procedures for the effect management of fire and other emergencies.

Staff members act as fire wardens.

Regular fire drills are held to test the effectiveness of the established fire action plan and to train pupils and staff to evacuate via the nearest exit.

During the day teaching staff are trained to evacuate all pupils, using the nearest exit and take them to the assembly point.

A registration is then taken where staff hold a green card up to confirm everyone is accounted for.

Inspection covered a full evacuation drill of all pupils and staff, science building, main office and Maths department. Due to the size of the school another inspection of the Prep School is planned. Maintenance Manager is fully co operate with improving fire safety provisions within the school and has made a considerable difference since joining the school in 2016. This includes ensuring all doors close fully, local station has regular familiarisation visits to ensure all chemicals and flammable substances are stored and labelled correctly. Storage has improved around the school. There are areas under the stairs that have 60 minutes fire resistance which staff keep to a minimum. Heads of departments are given the responsibility to keep on top of fire safety checks in their department daily.
