Request:

My request is for information relating to the fire risk at the above properties, which I understand has been subject to an ongoing investigation over the last few days.

I have been concerned as to the fire risk for several years at the property and would to know what steps the fire brigade have taken to stop the unlawful use within my properties.

Response:

A fire safety audit was carried out in February 2022 on Creative House 124 Prince of Wales Drive. The audit is still a live investigation and is not yet complete. The fire safety inspecting officer has three months to complete their audit findings. As a decision has not been made, we are unable to share any of the audit outcome with you.

When the LFB identifies any safety concerns, we make this information available within informal notification of fire safety deficiencies (NOD), and through the public register any formal action. You can find the public register of enforcement notices, here: [Notices on our website](#).

We would welcome a further request from you to obtain this information once the audit is complete. We recommend you resubmit your request again in a couple months.
