Request:

- 2. A breakdown of the number of malicious hoax calls you have received between November 2020 and November 2021 by London borough.
- 3. The cost these hoax calls have incurred in each year.

Our Data team have provided the table below which shows the number of incidents attended by crews which are believed to be malicious in nature:
