A LFB Inspecting Officer visited 232-234 KINGSBURY ROAD, NW9 on 08 September 2020. The officer noted "Scene of fire was inspected. This was an outbuilding under construction. 100% destroyed by fire and therefore unable to audit. Main premises under refurbishment and so effectively a building site."

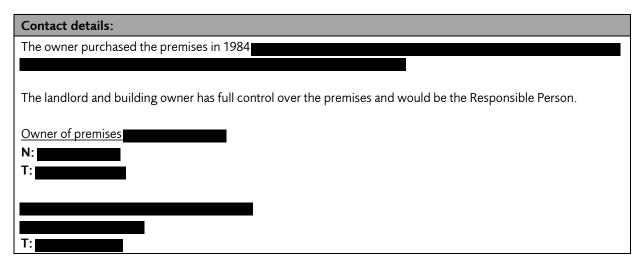

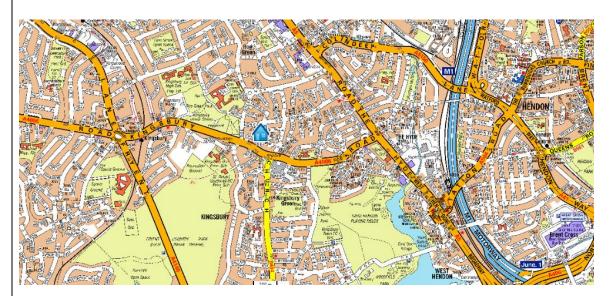

Premises description:

Overview

The building is set back from the main road on a multi use commercial site. Adjacent to the premises is a tyre retailer and the building itself has mixed use (two separate businesses and a single flat above).

Aerial overview (area highlighted in blue is approximate area of flat on first floor)

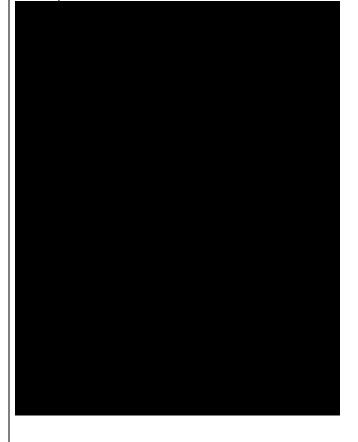

Side aspect (shows entrance to flat and flat above)



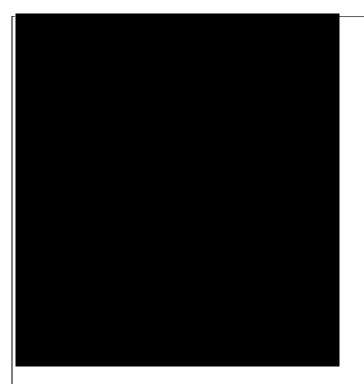

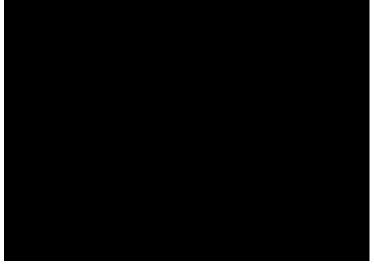
Fire safety issues:
The commerial premises was originally a single storey building when the current owner took possesion in 1984. Due to the limited means of escape and lack of any egress from the first floor the company of the flat were trapped during this fire and were only able to escape when rescued by BA crews.
Seperation between commercial premises on ground floor and residential sleeping accomodation above was insufficient.
Ignition sources
Although this fire appears to have started in the neighbouring premises and spread to this building it is clear that it prevented the ccupants of the fat from escaping.
In addition to the ignition sources which led to this particular fire the single means of escape and the commercial premises below has multiple ignition sources which would lead to an increased risk of a fire starting.

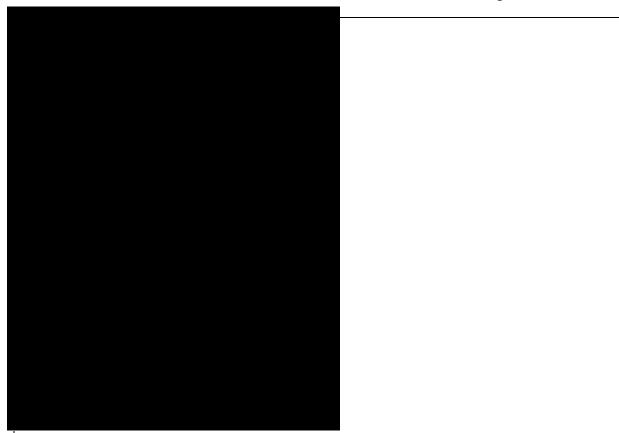

Lack of separation between commercial premises and inadequate means of escape

. Between the commercial printer business and the flat floor above there are a series of holes in the ceiling which have been used to access services. The door between the commercial premises and the means of escape for the flat is merely a thin sliding door which does not close flush to wall. If a fire was to start on the groun floor this would not prevent any smoke from compromising the escape and would be quickly consumed by a fire.
