*Please can you kindly confirm whether the owner was informed about the fire? If so, please confirm when was the owner first contacted about the fire? How was the owner contacted.*

**Response:**

Attending crews do not notify/contact property owners about incidents they attend. The stop message recorded for this incident ([LFB incident no. 012517-27012022](#)) states the duty of care was left the Metropolitan Police Service:
