## Request:

British Standard BS 7671 requires that all electrical equipment installed in buildings is required to be manufactured to a British Standard, and completion of an electrical installation certificate, (EIC) requires that any equipment not complying to a British Standard must be listed as a departure from the standards on an electrical safety certificate (EIC).

Your inspector has informed that if an electrical product has London Underground Approval for use, this exceeds the requirements of British Standards.

London Underground standard S1085 is often listed as the standard for product approval, this standard is for "Reaction to fire", can you please provide the London Underground standard that the LFB accept for "Resistance to Fire.

## Response:

The LFB Fire Safety Regulatory department have confirmed the LFB would not be required to keep this standard, it would be up to London Underground Limited (LUL)/Transport for London (TfL) to demonstrate.
