Request:

I am writing to request total costings of the Purley Fire Station and Metropolitan Police collaboration project from start to finish, including costings for changing facilities, bike racks, etc that were installed onsite.

Please could you also confirm who covered the cost of the project, or if costings were shared then the total amount each party paid.

Response:

The costs attributed to the co-location model where the Metropolitan Police Service (MPS) have occupied a room or have access to supporting facilities at Purley Fire Station are as follows:

- 1. The total cost of LFB Estates professional fees (from 2019 to 2021) to progress the Heads of Terms and licence to occupy was £3,082. This was covered by LFB.
- 2. The total MPS fit out costs for facilities, including the installation of bike racks were £10,666. This was covered by The Mayor's Office for Policing and Crime (MOPAC).
