Request:

I am researching surface water flooding in the Crays last October, which resulted in the evacuation of some residents from internally flooded properties on the Rookery Estate and Hodsoll Court and Hodson Crescent.

If they [LFB] attended and have data on the numbers and locations of properties affected, this information and any observations would be very valuable.

Response:

On 20 October 2022, the LFB attended 29 weather related flooding special service (non-fire) incidents in the "BR5 4" area.

We record very little information in relation to special service incidents. Below is a table showing a list of the 29 weather related flooding incidents attended on 20 October 2021, with a brief description of the action taken by the attending crews (ie. "Make safe"):

This dataset is updated monthly and contains details of:

- The type of incident (i.e. fire, false alarm, special service);
- The date/time incident occurred;
- The property type where incident took place (such as dwelling, commercial, car);
- The location of incident (Borough, fire station ground, postcode, USRN, latitude/longitude);
- How long it took first and second fire engine (pump) to arrive at incident;
- Where the fire engine(s) were deployed from;
- The number of fire engines that attended the incident;
- The length of time the fire engines stayed at the incident;
- The notional cost of the LFB attending the incident;

- The number of 999 calls received for each incident.
