Request:

In 2017, the LFB identified fire safety issues the Chalcots Estate in Camden. The towers were evacuated and remedial works were done before residents were moved back in.

There is a report available online

As it's not mentioned in the report, I'd like to know what checks the LFB did on the non-communal windows in the Chalcots Estate. By this I mean windows and window sills, including the spaces beneath them, inside flats in the Chalcots Estate. Can you send me reports or documents that detail the fire safety checking of non-communal windows in the estate in 2017? If no reports were done, please let me know.

If it is not possible to do this within the FOI budget, please just send me reports for the Taplow block of the Chalcots Estate.

Response:

I have checked our fire safety records and there is no record of a report relating to the non-communal windows in Chalcots estate.

Under the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 (RRO) The London Fire Brigade are responsible for checking fire safety in the common parts of flats. Therefore, non-communal windows would not be covered by this.

The London Borough of Camden hold updated information on the major works project and fire safety for Chalcots Estate this can be found on their website here - https://www.camden.gov.uk/chalcots-estate

The last fire safety audit in 2020 for Taplow, confirmed no significant failure to comply with the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 (RRO). As a result, the premises was deemed broadly compliant. This means that no enforcement action (informal or formal) was required as a result and no notices were issued by the LFB.

I attach a copy of the Fire Safety Audit Report for Taplow to this response. It can be found on pages 3 to 11 of this document.
