The LFB use an ASP.Net c# development, underpinned by a SQL database, to process these requests. It is managed in-house so there are no external costs associated with this software.

#### **Compliments and Complaints**

These are processed on an Access database. The database was provided by Aztec Computing. Any support/development costs are included under a wider contract with Aztec Computing.
