Request:

We are trying to analyse dwelling fires caused by cooking. We have seen the published summary data for England and Wales. We are trying to get more granular data so we can see for example that a particular retirement home has had x cooking fires in the last 10 years, so we can understand and target the solution better for the properties where people are most at risk.

Do you have the data for the LFB incident records, but including the CAUSE_OF_FIRE code that we could use to extract this information?

Our data team have provided the table below, showing the number of cooking fires recorded in retirement homes in the last 10 years:

We do not include the cause of fire code on the <u>incident report dataset</u> online.
