## Request:

I would like to request data on the number of fires your service has tackled caused by 'E-Bikes' during the last 3 years, including 2022, if this data is available

## Response:

I have attached a table with the most recent figures for the number of fires attended where all types of lithium battery were believed to be the cause (this included e-bike and e-scooter lithium batteries).

Please note, the data in the table includes incidents that were recorded under a new ignition source for 'e-bike' and 'e-scooter' as well as a free text search (for historical data) on e-bikes, e-scooters, e-cigarettes and other lithium battery devices. As a result of using the free text search, the historical data may not be 100% accurate.
