*Copies of all current Data Sharing Agreements between the London Fire Brigade and the Metropolitan Police Service*

**Response:**

The LFB do not hold any data sharing agreements purely with the Metropolitan Police Service. However, we do hold data sharing agreements with the Emergency Services and other Stake holders. The data sharing agreements with the Metropolitan Police is part of a wider authority sharing agreement.

The GLA run safe stats a crime and disorder partnership, which the LFB data team upload data to monthly. This allows sharing with the Police other Emergency Services and London Boroughs. I have linked to the website which holds the data sharing agreement.

Schedule 2, Part 1, Paragraph 2(a)(b) (Crime and Taxation) of Data Protection Act (DPA) 2018 provides exemption from application of UK GDPR provision on transparency and individual rights, if complying with the regulation would prejudice prevention and detection of crime, or the apprehension and prosecution of offender.

Similarly, Schedule 1, Part 2, Paragraph 10 of DPA 2018 provides condition for sharing special category and criminal offence data where it is necessary for the prevention and detection of unlawful acts.
