Further to your request, I can confirm a Fire Safety Audit Assessment has been taken for the Smoking Shelter, 232-234 Kingsbury Road, London. The first assessment was completed on the 15<sup>th</sup> January 2013. A more recent Fire Safety Audit assessment was scheduled for the 8<sup>th</sup> October 2020 but was cancelled. However, a Premises Risk assessment was taken on the 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2020.
