The information you have requested is published online on the [London Datastore](#). It can be found using a combination of the [London Fire Brigade Incident Records](#) and the [Fires in Greater London - Fire Facts](#).

Upon downloading the Incident Records excel spreadsheet, the filter will provide any incidents in relation to Newham using column 'Q', 'IncGeo_BoroughName'.

Fire Facts spreadsheet under tab 2.3 you can find the number of fires incidents by borough and tab 2.8 gives the number of fatalities by borough.

Although we do not record statistics classified by vulnerable people. We have a report on [Community Risks](#) that can be sorted by year and borough to give information about high risks statistics and trends in the borough.

If you are interested in more detailed reports, you may be interested in [Safe Stats](#) which is run by the GLA. Local Authorities can sign up to it as it forms part of our generic data sharing agreement.
