Request:

Please advise if any LFB crews documented delays to their vehicles on the incident reporting system that were attributed to the Just Stop Oil protests that took place on Whitehall on Monday 6 November 2024.

Did you have staff co-located with other emergency responders on the day, and if not, have the Met Police been in contact with you about this protest, to enquire about any delays caused to the London Fire Brigade as a result of the protest?

Response:

LFB does not hold this information regarding the Just Stop Oil protests on Monday 6 November. Our Operational Resilience and Control Department have confirmed that the LFB deployed mitigation measures by co-locating a Commander with partners to minimise the impact. They have the authority and ability to guide our resources to the location where they are needed without delay. However, we publish information about all fire engine mobilisations as part of our Open data on the [London Datastore](#). This data also records if fire engines are held up on route to incidents. However, there is no specific delay code description for "*demonstrations*".
