LFB have a contract with Bellrock to undertake their CAFM services for facilities management. The CAFM software is Concerto.

2) What is the start date and duration of the contract(s)?

The contract start date was 1st April 2021 and expires on 31st March 2026.

3) Is there an extension clause in the contract(s) and, if so, the duration of the extension?

The contract may be extended by no more than 24 months.

4) Has a decision been made yet on whether the contract(s) will be extended or renewed?

Not at this point in time.

5) What is the annual value of the contract(s)?

The cost of the CAFM software is £40,008 currently (this does inflate yearly).

6) What is the total contract value of each contract?

The total cost of the CAFM software over the fixed term of the contract is \pounds 200,214.09 (excluding extensions).

7) How was the contract(s) procured, e.g., framework/tender?

This was procured via a traditional tender route and was not procured via a Framework.
