## Request:

I'm a geotechnical engineer working on a site which was attended by LFB in 2022, and I am looking into potential land contamination resulting from the fire so it can be redeveloped for housing, particularly PFAS contamination from fire-fighting foam.

The site address is 84A RAILWAY SIDINGS, SHAKESPEARE ROAD, SE24 0PT, it was a waste transfer station, and the incident occurred on 8th September 2022.

Could you/one of your colleagues in a relevant department let me know if PFAS-containing fire-fighting foam was used on site (or likely to have been), or whether PFAS-containing foam was phased out by the LFB in this area by this time?

## Response:

In response to your question above, we can confirm no foam was used during the incident at 84A Railway Sidings.

The Hose – Main Jet and Hosereel high pressure were used at this incident.
