I would like to know if external candidates for the recent Group Commander process run by the LFB had to undertake a Incident Command Exercise, or if indeed they were not required to and instead be given an average score. - All external candidates who didn't have a level 6 Skills for Justice qualification or if they had a level 6 Skills for Justice qualification but not "in-ticket", they had to undertake an ICE assessment and achieve the pass mark of 75% or above. For those external candidates who had a level 6 Skills for Justice qualification and were "in-ticket", they were given an average score.
