Request:

NHBC Building Control services issued a Final Certificate for a building dated 28th June 2010. The building is two block of student accommodation referred to on the certificate as address as Lavington Street/Great Suffolk Street, London, SE1 0. An Initial Notice for this project was issued to the local authority dated 27th November 2008. At some point between these two dates NHBC Building Control would have undertaken statutory consultation with LFB/LFEPA as part of their dealing with the building regulation application. I would like a copy of all letter correspondence issued by LFB/LFEPA in connection with that consultation and a copy of any letter/document issued by NHBC documenting their assessment of the buildings compliance. I do not want any plans or other design details. The building is currently known as Chapter Southbank and is used as student accommodation and the address is identified as 17 Great Suffolk Street, London, SE1 0NS
