Request:

LFB supposedly gave Tower Hamlets Community Housing in 2019 (around August) that motorbikes could no longer be kept in the motorbike cage at the bottom of Winterton House E1. I have spoken with multiple LFB employees who have attended this building for other reasons and none have or would have had an issue with said motorbike as they told me the cage is open fronted and Winterton House is built of brick. Who told THCH that bikes could no longer be kept in the designated cage?

Response:

Our Fire Safety Team last carried out an audit at this property in 2018. There was nothing recorded on the audit that mentions the storage of motorbikes.

I have checked if the local fire station has noted anything related to the premises on our database and there is nothing recorded about where the motorbikes are stored.

We do not hold any information about the storage of the motorbikes at this premises. You may wish to check if it was part of the fire safety risk assessment for the building that would be maintained by the Responsible Person for the premises.
