Request:

I am writing to request information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 regarding incidents involving e-bike fires on the London Underground.

Specifically, I would like to know:

- 1. The number of e-bike fires that have occurred on each tube line since 2016 to the present day.
- 2. If available, the date and location (i.e., the specific station or part of the line) of each incident.
- 3. The number that have occurred on the overground lines and bus network

Please provide the information in a format that allows for easy analysis, such as an Excel spreadsheet.

Response:

We have record of two incidents that mention electric vehicles on underground stations as shown below:

We have one incident involving an e-scooter that occurred in a ticket office at ground level:
