Request:

Following notification that LFB will no longer respond to automatic fire signals in daytime for non-residential buildings:

- Is there an acceptation to this?
- Is this only the case if a single smoke detector has activated without being confirmed by a keyholder?
- Will LFB respond straight away to coincidence activations? (two independent smoke detectors activating in the same zone).
- Will LFB respond straight away to activations from Manual Call Points, Heat Detectors or Multi sensing Detectors?
