What was the cost incurred by LFB in attending the Barons Court station incident 22nd-23rd January 2023
i) of LFB resources
ii) of any external resources engaged by LFB

Response:

I have checked the records for incidents at Barons Count on 22nd -23rd January 2023. I have identified 2 incidents that we attended on those dates.

The incident on the 22 January 2023 was classified as a Special Services incident – assistance in removing a person from a train roof. This was recorded as incident number 010640-22012023.

On the 23 January 2023 we attended a secondary fire in the shrub land nearby. The incident number for this is 11004-23012023.
