**Request:**

Hello Please could you provide me the number of people who were 'exited' (as per the Commissioners term on the 5th December to the London Assembly Committee) from the LFB who have since been re-engaged either as contractors, agency or short term contracts. If that number is fewer than 5 but more than none I appreciate there is the issue of identifying an individual. If it is between 1-5 people re-engaged in some way in which the LFB is either paying an agency, a company or an individual in such a way please just confirm yes. If it is zero please say no. If it is more than 5 please say how many. Could you tell me also how many of the six who were 'exited' from the LFB were uniformed and how many of the seven who "resigned with loss of pension, loss of rights, before they ever got to that hearing" (the Commissioners words from the same committee) were uniformed.

Please could you provide me with the total number of people, broken down by uniformed and non-uniformed staff, who have been 'exited' from the LFB for each of the last five years.

**Response:**

Further to your request, I can confirm that the number of staff that have returned to LFB after exiting is zero.

*Could you tell me also how many of the six who were 'exited' from the LFB were uniformed and how many of the seven who "resigned with loss of pension, loss of rights, before they ever got to that hearing" (the Commissioners words from the same committee) were uniformed.*

Further to the Commissioner's comments, from the six staff who exited the LFB, four were uniformed members of staff. From the seven staff members whom resigned before attending a hearing, six staff were uniformed.

*Please could you provide me with the total number of people, broken down by uniformed and non-uniformed staff, who have been 'exited' from the LFB for each of the last five years.*
