Request:

I would like to make a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 in respect of the below three buildings (blocks of flats, total of 372 residential flats):

Stretton Mansions, Millennium Quay, Glaisher Street, Greenwich, London, SE8 3JP and SE8 3JR

Thistley Court, Millennium Quay, Glaisher Street, Greenwich, London SE8 3JW

Greenfell Mansions, Millennium Quay, Glaisher Street, Greenwich, London SE8 3EU and SE8 3EX

- 1. In view of the attached message received today from our Residents Management Company about the immediate need for a waking watch, I would like to know if the London Fire Brigades have been informed and have attended the site.
- 2. I would also like to know from you which are the reasons for imposing the waking watch and whether the London Fire Brigade have found any irregularity or breach of Fire Safety legislation or any breach of other relevant regulation at the above building.

Response:

Please see my response to each of your queries in turn below:

1. In view of the attached message received today from our Residents Management Company about the immediate need for a waking watch, I would like to know if the London Fire Brigades have been informed and have attended the site.

The Prevention & Protection (Fire Safety) team have provided us with emails from Millennium Quay Services confirming that the waking watch is to be implemented. The emails have been provided in the attached to this response.

Our Prevention and Protection (Fire Safety) team have confirmed there is an open fire safety audit record for Stretton Mansions, Thistley Court and Greenfell Mansions.

As the audit is still a live investigation, and is not yet complete, no decisions have been made that can be shared with you at the present time. The inspecting officer has three months to complete their audit findings from the date of inspection. You are welcome to resubmit your request once the fire safety audit process has been completed.

2. I would also like to know from you which are the reasons for imposing the waking watch and whether the London Fire Brigade have found any irregularity or breach of Fire Safety legislation or any breach of other relevant regulation at the above building.

Waking watches in unsafe buildings are not imposed by the fire service, they are put in place by the person responsible for fire safety in each building, such as the building owner or manager, based on the findings and recommendations of a competent fire safety person and should be captured as part of their Fire Risk Assessment.

While the Brigade has a role in enforcing fire safety legislation, it does not make a decision on which interim measures are put in place in a building. However, the Brigade's fire safety inspectors will not leave an unsafe building without any safety measures in place due to the significant risk to residents. The Brigade accepts that in some cases a waking watch is the only viable option until a common alarm is fitted, other than evacuating the whole building.

At this moment in time, we do have a station notification that provides us with some information about what was found at the 3 blocks of flats Dated 4^{th of} October. Please see the Station Notification in this response.

However, as the audit is still a live investigation, and is not yet complete, no decisions or findings have been made or found that can be shared with you at the present time. You are welcome to resubmit your request once the fire safety audit process has been completed.
